Post-fire debris flow community safety meetings scheduled

VENTURA, Calif. – A series of community debris flow safety meetings have been scheduled at locations around the Thomas Fire burn area.

The Sheriff's Office of Emergency Services, in cooperation with other city and county agencies, the U.S. Forest Service and Cal Fire, has identified 10 zones around the burn area which may be subject to post-fire debris or mud flows. The zones vary depending on their geology, slope and other factors, so residents are encouraged to attend the meeting for their zone.

Each meeting will include in-depth descriptions of the analysis which took place to determine the mud and debris flow risks created by the fire. Speakers will discuss alert and warning notifications; evacuation areas and terminology; and community and personal emergency preparedness. Spanish-language translators and sign language interpreters will be available at all of the meetings.
